## ***ANNA LINDH NETWORK B&H ANNUAL NETWORK MEMBER MEETING***

**REPORT FROM THE WORKSHOP FOR THE REPRESENTATIVES OF ALF B&H NETWORK  
“NETWORKING AND WRITING PROJECT PROPOSALS”**

***MOSTAR, STUDENT HOTEL  
03RD -5TH SEPTEMBER 2015***

Second and third day of the ALF B&H network meeting was dedicated to the workshop on topics networking and writing project proposals.

Workshop started in the afternoon of the second day, at the workshop was discussed about starting project partnerships as part of the ALF B&H network, inter network cooperation which aim would be to promote ALF B&H and network visibility, promotion of intercultural cooperation with other networks in Balkan and Mediterranean (writing project proposals).

Third day was reserved for work on making and adopting partnerships inside the ALF B&H network and project propositions for inter network and intercultural cooperation.

Workshop had interactive and participatory character, meaning work in smaller groups and active involvement of all participants during whole workshop.

Although the agenda and workshop plan has come in to questions at the very beginning, because of announced call by the ALF secretariat (were some of the participants have expressed desire to start with writing applications at the workshops), deal was made to start with situation analysis as well as capacity assessment of the ALF B&H network members and in accordance to make work groups for making project propositions for the both calls:

LOT 1: Education for intercultural citizens and LOT 2: Intercultural art co-production.

It was planned to divide participants in to four smaller groups after the SWOT analysis to elect on group leader and they would give one idea for the project.

After analysis and division in to groups, five projects were conceived. Ideas were presented to whole group and after discussion and additional propositions were defined as project ideas. All project ideas include all present organizations and for each idea a person is in charge to lead the application process.
